

Project Management – Higher Apprenticeship 48 month programme

What is Project Management?

Project Management involves initiating, planning, executing and controlling the work of a team to achieve the project objectives.

What will I be doing?

This is a four year scheme which offers on the job learning across a broad range of project delivery areas. Aligned to the new Associate Project Manager Trailblazer scheme, you will gain Project Management experience whilst also gaining a professional Project Management academic qualification. Your placements will span across a range of project delivery roles within Sellafield Ltd, which include Project Management, Project Controls, Risk Management, Construction, Commissioning and Pre-Operations.

What do I need to consider?

This is a four year scheme and you will work towards the Association for Project Management PMQ certification and a Foundation Degree (FdSc) in Project Management. If you like to own a piece of work from start to finish, this is a role you will get a lot of satisfaction from. You will be working alongside world class experts in the industry and involved on projects that are brand new and at the forefront of innovation and problem solving. You will be tested and challenged as you work under demanding timelines. You will need to be an effective communicator to influence the project team and help to ensure the team maintains its momentum to deliver the cost, time, quality and safety requirements.

Where will my training be delivered?

Based on the Sellafield site you will start a rotation programme of a number of placements covering project delivery roles. This will include two 6 month placements per year and one 12 month placement in your final year.

Your Foundation Degree in Project Management will be delivered by University of Cumbria through the Project Academy for Sellafield.

What qualifications will I obtain?

- Association for Project Management PMQ.
- Foundation Degree (FdSc) in Project Management.

What are the entry requirements?

- Minimum of 3 GCSE grade C (step
 4) in Mathematics, English Language and one Science subject.
- Minimum of 96 UCAS points. All A-Level subjects considered. Other Level 3 qualifications may be considered.
